Here are some fun facts of how the Cooke County Library educated, engaged and enriched the community in

2015:

- The Library gained 842 new patrons.
- The library checked out 75,244 items to it's patrons
- The library sponsored and offered 133 programs 112 were just for children

- The Library offered 5 additional eResource databases. There were 7,459 items accessed and 2,923 items downloaded from these 5 online resources.
- The library had 7,895 patrons use our computers and 10,444 patrons use our free Wi-Fi service.
- The Library received 4 grants for a total of \$10,220.39 in 2015. These grants were used for updating technology like computers, iPads, a 3D printer, materials to enhance specific areas in the adult non-fiction, children and young adult collections, reimbursement for participating in the Inter library loan program and an on-line magazine database.

**The Friends of the Cooke County Library funded the eResource OneClick Digital and purchased the books for the 9 Literary LEGOS programs for kids in 2015.
